Environmental Conference in Togo

On 26th June 2015, Michael Stephen was the keynote speaker at an Environmental conference in Togo. The Chairman of the conference was the Environment Minister of Togo and it was attended by senior officials from the West African Union (UEMOA) and from the following West African Countries, Benin, Burkino-Faso, Senegal, Mali, Cote D'Ivoire, Guinea-Bisseau and Niger.

The consensus of the meeting was that Oxo-biodegradable plastic technology is essential for dealing with plastic waste which escapes collection and accumulates in the open environment, where it can lie or float around for decades.

Oxo-biodegradable plastic is included at the manufacturing stage and converts ordinary plastic products into biodegradable materials, at the end of their useful life. If collected it can be recycled with other plastic products but if not it will degrade and biodegrade in the open environment in months rather than years, without leaving fragments of plastic behind or toxic residues.
